

Nature lovers, bird lovers, and bird watchers recognize National Bird Day on January 5th. SKP Resort Members and Guests were able to do a little bird watching when a flock of White Pelicans and Wood Storks visited the pond earlier this week.

White Pelicans are like the Brown Pelicans found year-round in Florida but they are much larger in size with wing spans up to 9feet wide. White Pelicans do not dive to catch fish but rather swim on the surface of the water dipping their bills into the water to scoop up the fish. White Pelicans will often winter in Central and Coastal Florida. In the summer, live colonies they in Northwestern US and Canada.


