In the event of an emergency here at the park, a text or voice mail is sent to the members in residence as well as registered visitors. Visitors are added and removed according to their registration information in the office.

To keep the cost of the service under control, emergency messages are sent to the primary number for each membership and visitors who are currently in residence.

Every effort is made to ensure all the appropriate people in the park receive emergency messages.

However, maintaining an up-to-date residence list is dependent upon your taking responsibility for keeping the office informed as follows:

- seasonal members notifying the office of their return date to the park.
- members as well as visitors who will be out of the park for one or more
- overnights and their expected return date.
- members who are leaving until next season.

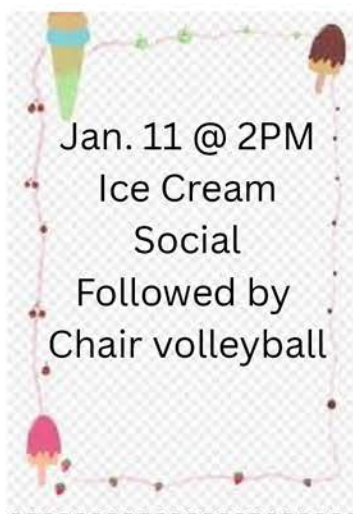
